2. Difficulties

- *♦ Bilateral mechanism;*
- ♦ Mechanism for distributing credits still unclear, esp. after converted into tradable credit type.
- ♦ Lack of information for Vietnam's enterprises.



Promoting JCM

- Cooperating with Japanese counterparts to review and strengthen the project procedures and financial mechanism;
- Developing JCM Circular in Vietnam guiding the project cycle and procedures;
- Forming technical advisory board for JCM;
- Organizing JCM introduction workshops to government agencies and business sector;
- Building a Vietnamese JCM website; developing and publishing JCM manuals.
