What is ISO14080?

- Propose by the leadership of BSN, Indonesia and JISC, Japan
- Develop 70 experts with UNFCCC secretariat, World Bank, Gold Standard, WRI
- Provides guidance for organizations to manage climate actions
- A framework for new and existing methodologies
- Global perspective – mitigation and adaptation
- Improves consistency and comparability of methodologies



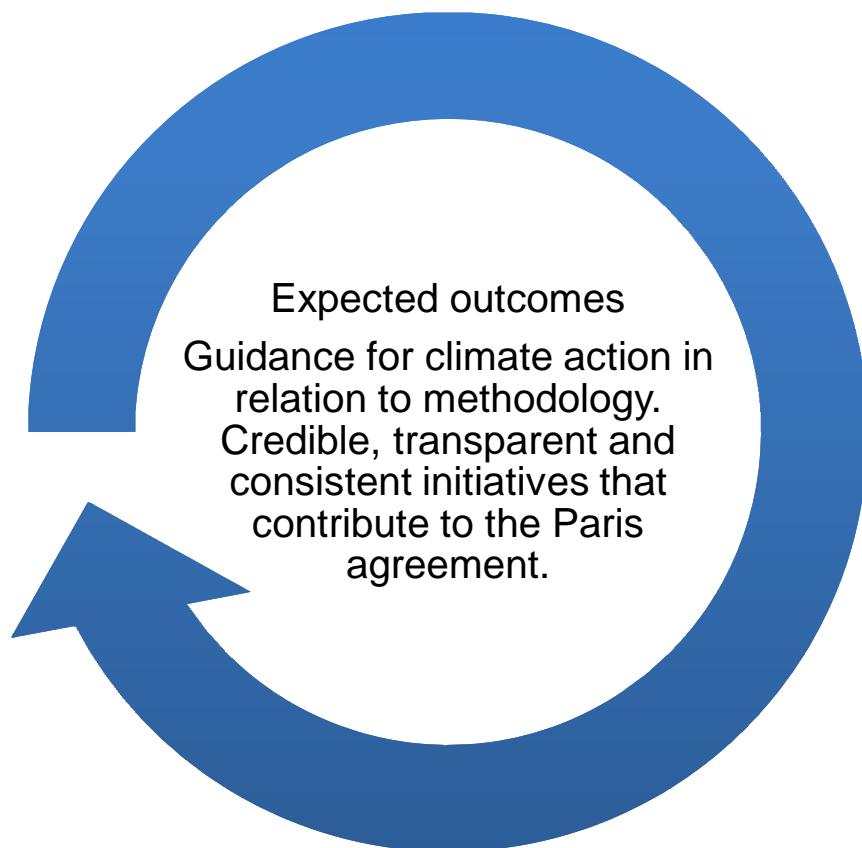
How can we use ISO14080?

- Encourages appropriate controls, shares best practice
- Promotes international co-operation and contributes to Paris agreement
- The methodology can be applicable to technology and policy deployment
- Encourages non state actors
- Recognition of need for governments to increase activities
- Transparency and consistency in methodologies

What is a framework of methodology?

1. Collects information from relevant policies
2. Sets objectives and goals
3. Identifies and assesses potential, existing and proposed methodologies
4. Assesses the effectiveness of the framework
5. Considers public consultation for stakeholders
6. Reviews and updates the framework of the methodology, as applicable

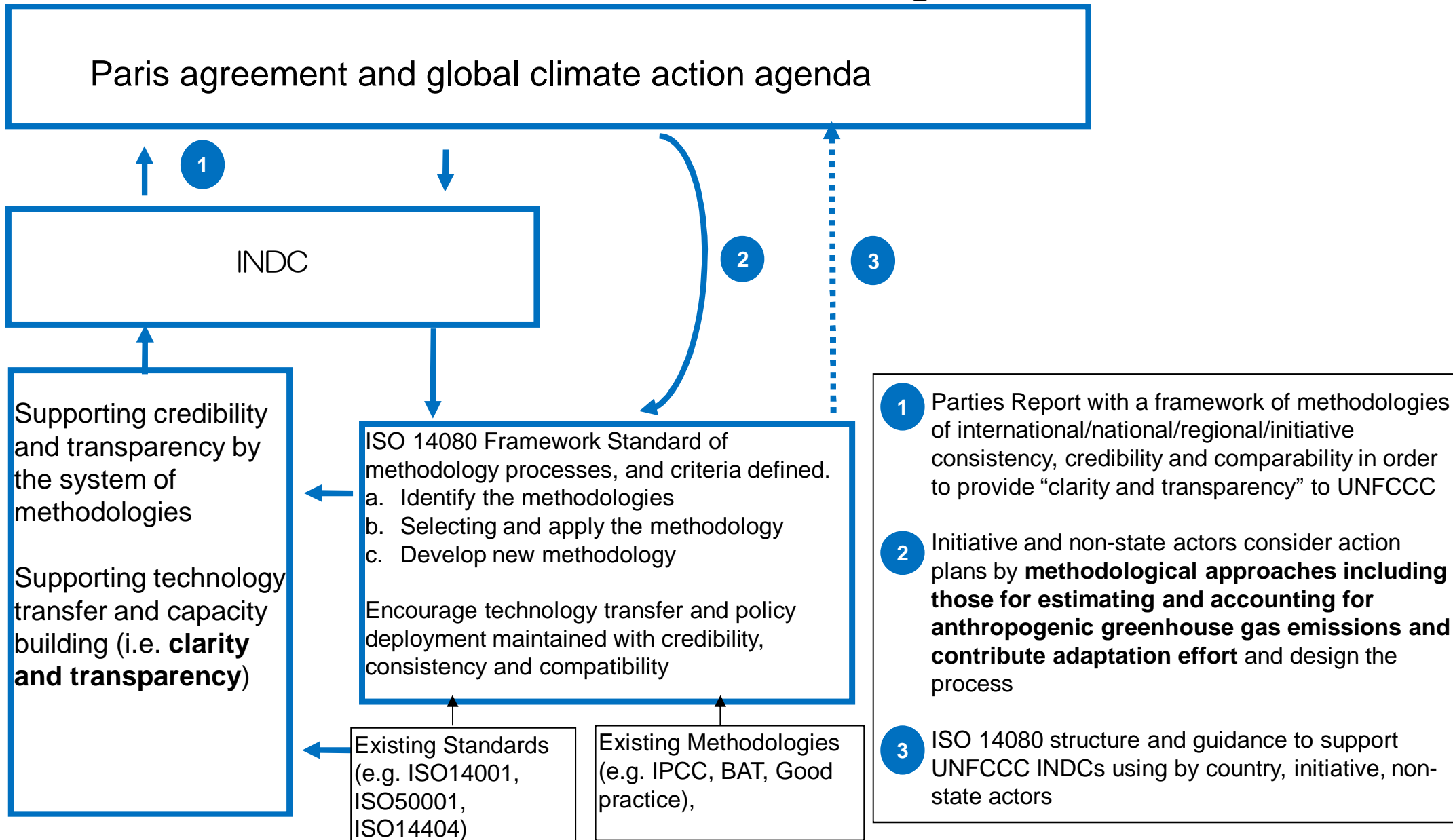
Policy and framework of methodology contributes to Paris agreement
