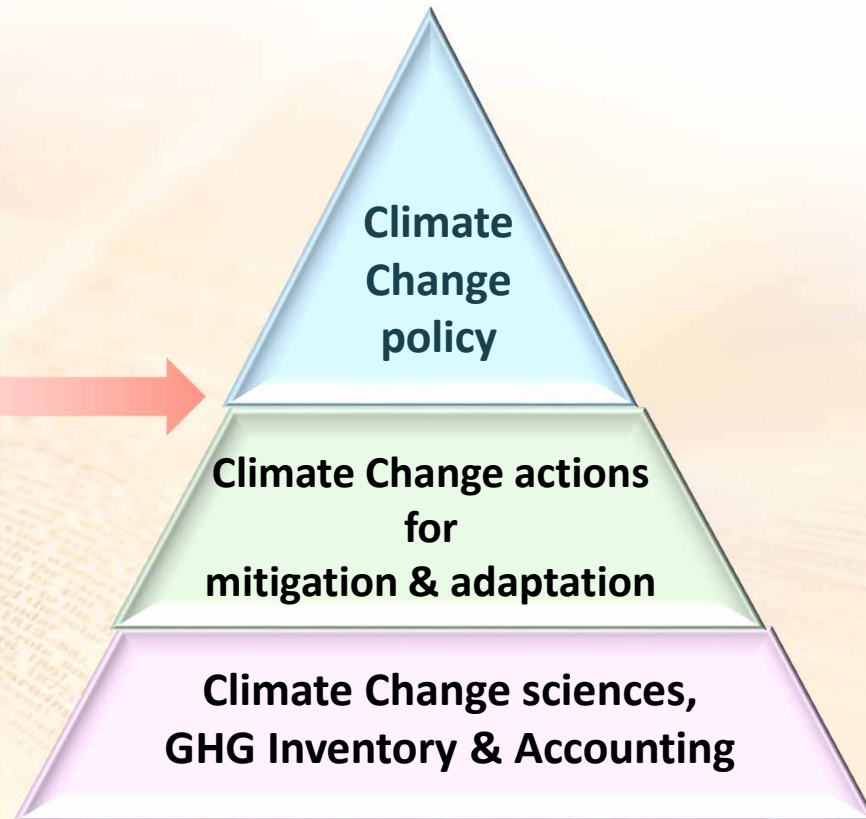
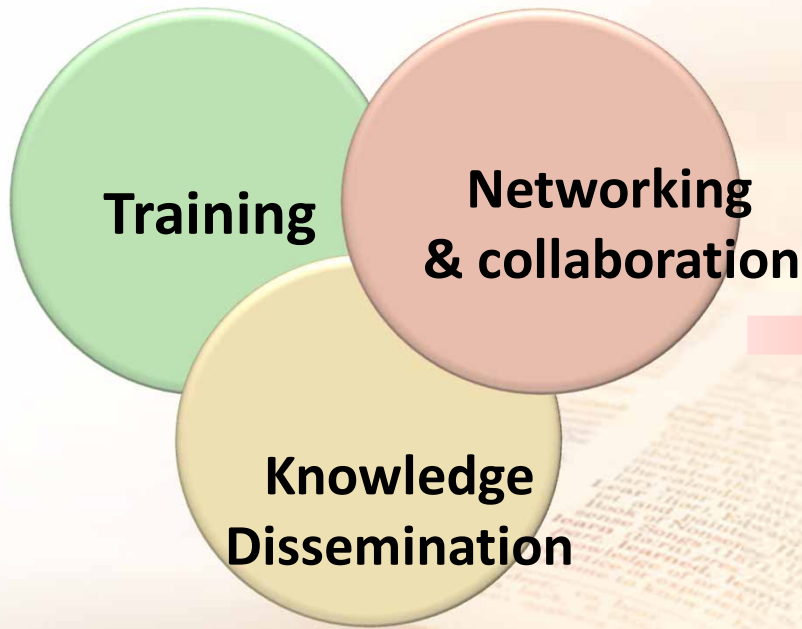
- Climate Change International Technical and Training Center (CITC) is :

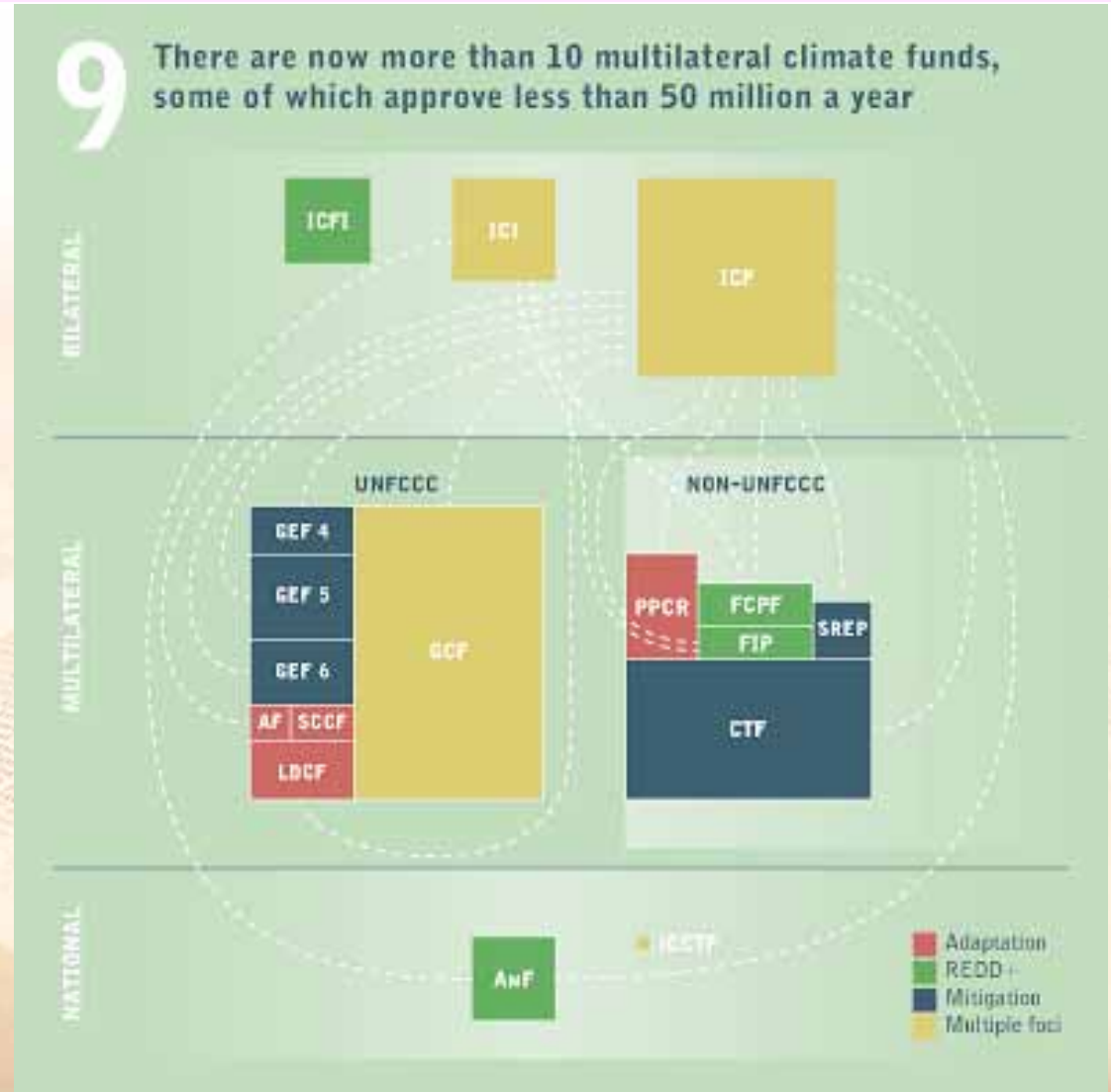

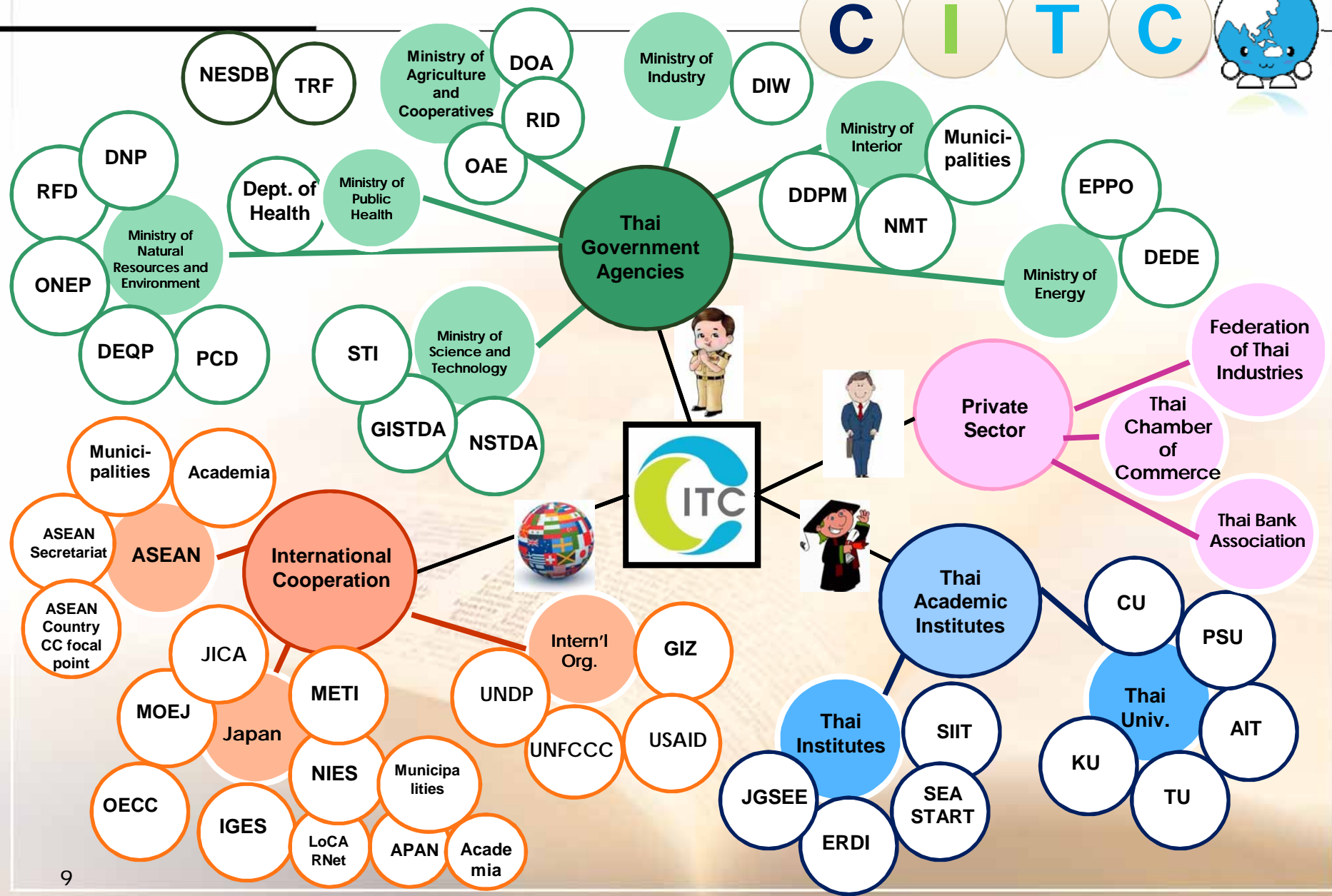

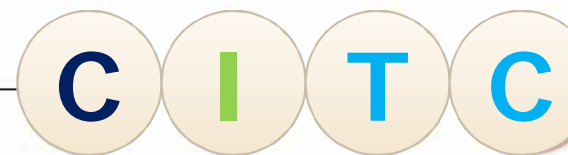
