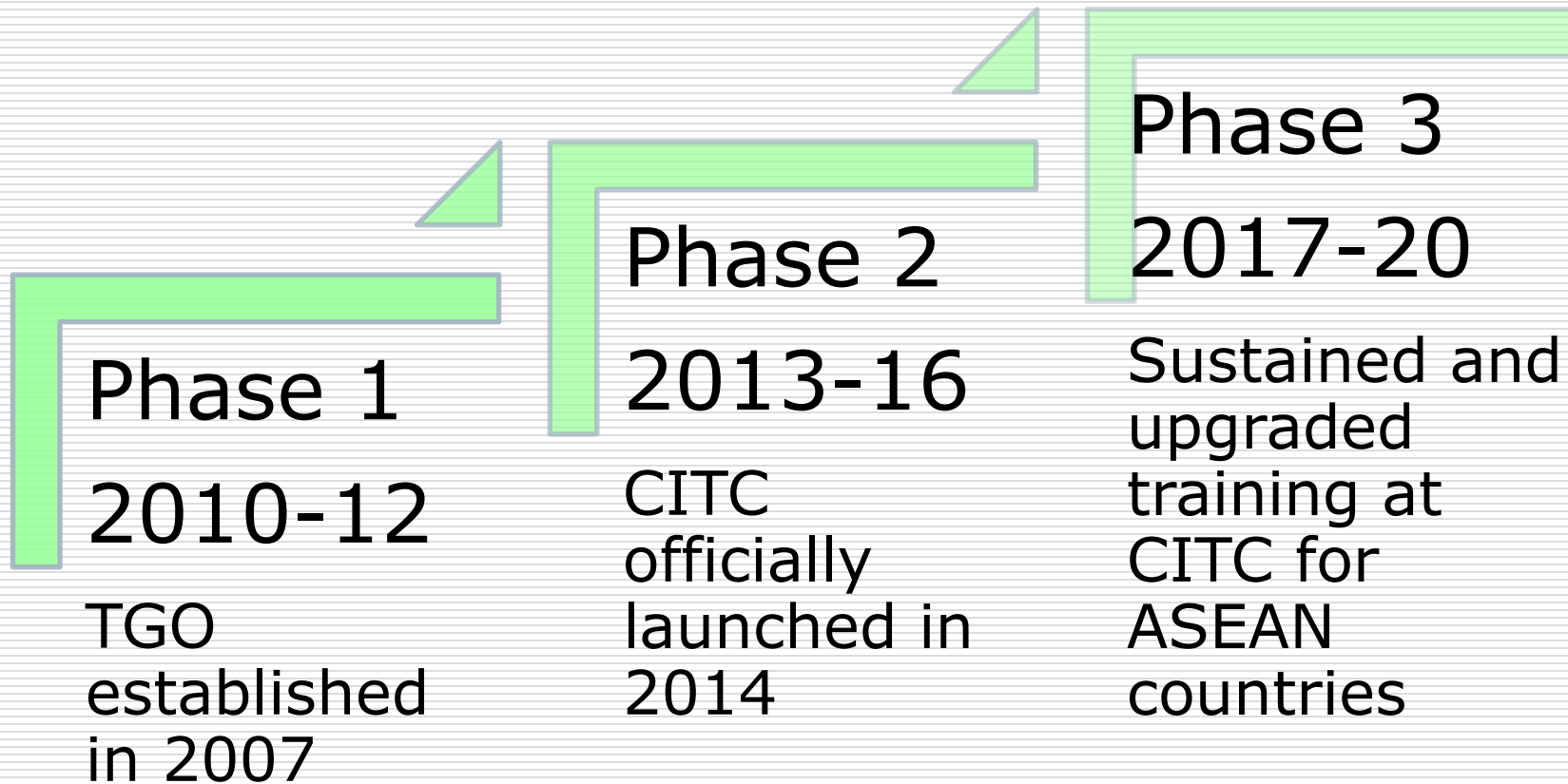

Three phases of cooperation with TGO/ CITC



Capacity Development and Institutional Strengthening for GHG Mitigation (2010-12)

- Capacity development of TGO
 - The level of knowledge and expertise of TGO staff on GHG mitigation is enhanced.
 - Capacity of TGO to review and monitor GHG mitigation projects is enhanced.
 - Capacity of TGO to manage information on GHG mitigation is enhanced.
 - Capacity of TGO to provide training is enhanced.

Capacity Development on Climate Change Mitigation/Adaptation in the Southeast Asia Region (2013-16)

- CITC was officially launched in 2014.
 - Institutional framework
 - Information management
 - Training needs assessment in the region
 - Developing training program & curriculum
 - Developing training resources
 - Building network
- Training started to be provided for the region.

Capacity Development to Accelerate Low Carbon and Resilient Society Realization in the Southeast Asia Region (2017-20)

- Aspiration for “*one-stop technical & training center of the region*”.
- CITC’s training courses will be sustained and upgraded.
- Support climate change actions in the region.

Project Outline

◆ Overall Goal

Accelerate realization of actions to address climate change in Thailand and other Southeast Asian countries through **Climate Change International Technical and Training Center (CITC)**.

◆ Project Purpose

Enhance the capacity of CITC to assist stakeholders to develop and realize climate change activities as a well-known “one-stop training center of the region.”

◆ Counterpart agency

Thailand Greenhouse Gas Management Organization (Public Organization) (TGO)

◆ Project Period

September 2017 to September 2020 (3 Years)

Project Activities (1)

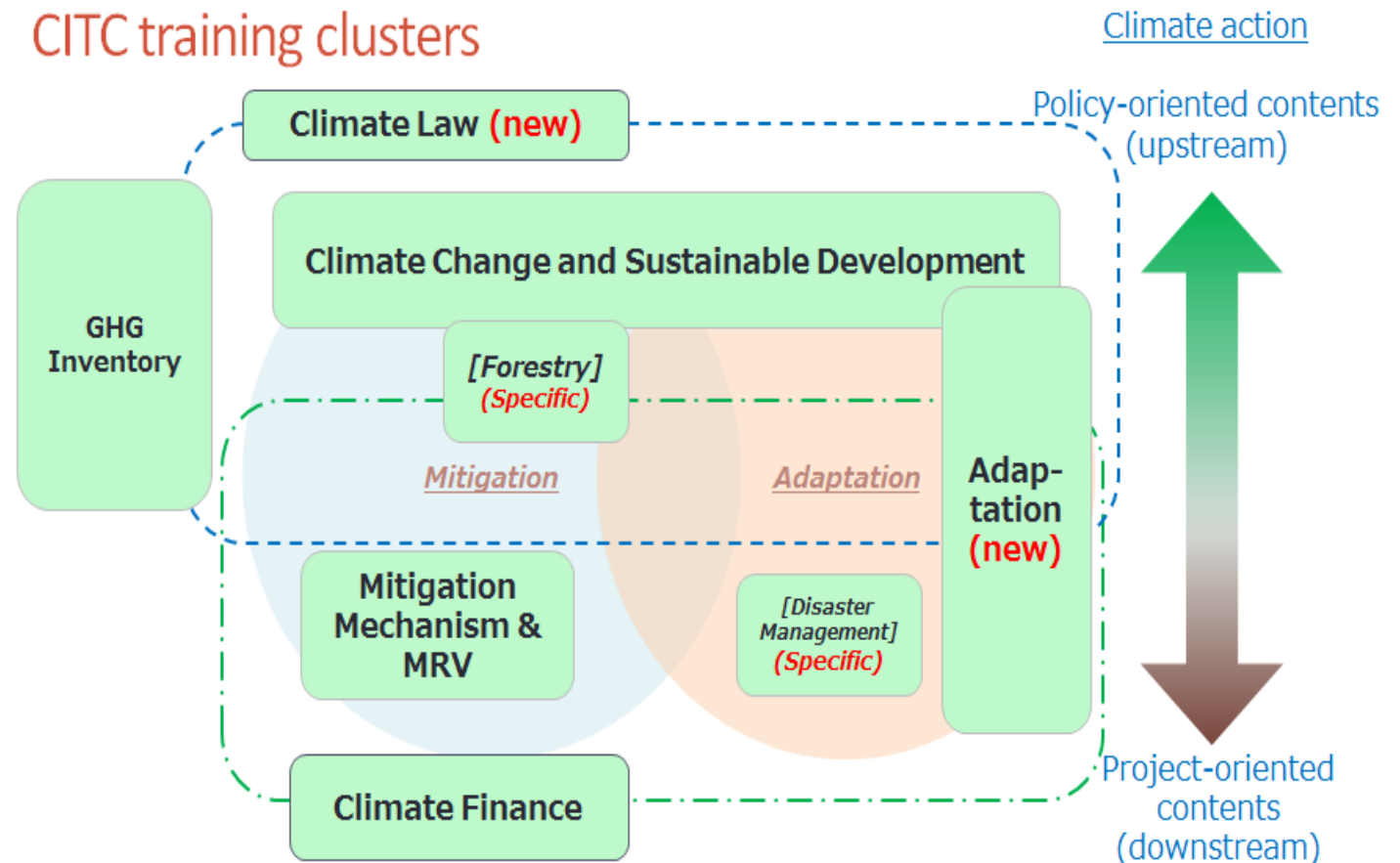
Output 1: CITC's training courses are sustained and upgraded

- ◆ Improve and develop various training courses in CITC
- ◆ Develop training materials
- ◆ Enhance training management

→ JICA will support CITC to develop practical training courses for various stakeholders in Southeast Asia

➤ Training that meets a wide range of capacity building needs

➤ Training that leads to implementation of NDC and NAP



Project Activities (2)

Output 2: Planning and implementation of climate actions in Thailand and other countries in Southeast Asia is supported through CITC training

- ◆ Develop specific training courses

→ Support in developing bankable proposals to donors/ funds

- ◆ Promote bilateral cooperation

→ Mutual learning between Thailand and Vietnam/ Lao PDR/ other countries

Output 3: Direction towards achieving the sustainability of CITC is established

- ◆ Revise and implement “CITC Business Plan”
- ◆ Disseminate lessons learnt through CITC Regional Conferences, media and publications
- ◆ Design a prototype of ‘Digital Capacity Building Gateway’
