
Papua New Guinea Climate Change and Development Authority "Roles and Responsibilities"

The CCDA is the National Designated Authority that has been assigned responsibility to implement the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement in collaboration with line agencies. The CCDA's objective is "to provide a coordination mechanism at the national level for research, analysis and development of the policy and legislative framework for the management of climate change within the Government's National Strategy on Climate-Compatible Development" (NEC Decision No 55/2010).





The MRV & National Communication is primarily responsible in developing and maintaining a comprehensive MRV system that will allow to measure, report and verify the rate of greenhouse gas emissions and comply with the requirements of global climate change rules (e.g. UNFCCC). Furthermore the division is responsible to communicate PNG's Greenhouse Gas emissions as required by international treaties (BUR/NC)

PNG's Government Commitments to Climate Change




Institutional Arrangement by Coordinating Agency






Institutional Arrangement by Sectors


